May is the month for graduations, a time to celebrate accomplishments and to look forward to new beginnings. (I just attended a graduation, ask me about it only if you can endure bragging.) AGA operates on the same calendar, with the program year ending in May and another beginning in June. The Central Kentucky Chapter's 2014-15 program year yielded much to celebrate.

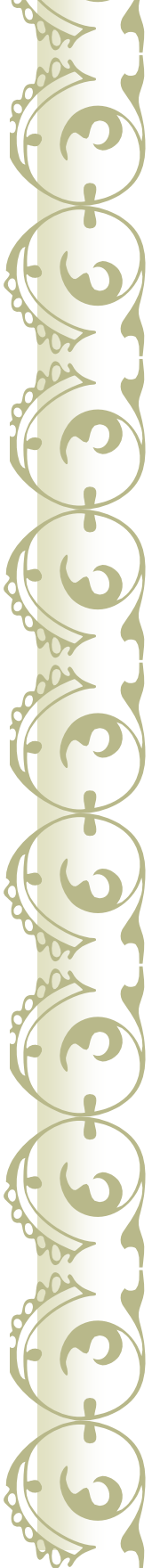
We held 9 regular monthly meetings that awarded 1 hour each of CPE. A diverse group of speakers, many of whom we'd never previously heard, helped increase our knowledge of and insight into the workings of government. Fall and spring PDTs featured nationally known speakers Mike Inzina and David Cotton. Combined, at the PDTs the chapter offered 16 hours of CPE and welcomed nearly 300 participants. Because these events successfully served our members (and more), we end the program year in a strong financial position. This enabled us to make \$250 quarterly community service donations to Simon House (plus \$259.49 to match spring PDT candy sales), the Franklin County Humane Society, the Franklin County Fire Department toy drive, and the Frankfort Food Pantry. We also thanked monthly speakers by donating \$25 to the charity of their choice, and we accepted a challenge from AGA's San Antonio chapter by donating \$105 to purchase 7 wreaths to decorate graves at Arlington last Christmas.

Last fall we published a Citizen-Centric Report to inform members and others about the chapter's accomplishments and challenges for the 2013-14 program year. This report received a Certificate of Excellence. In March we celebrated CGFM Month, which Governor Beshear proclaimed state-wide. Finally, we are about to award two \$1,000 college scholarships to accounting undergraduates.

As with raising a child, it takes a village to create an impact as great as the Central Kentucky Chapter has made over the past year. I want to thank each of our members for supporting the chapter through attending monthly meetings and PDTs, encouraging and networking with one another, renewing membership with all its benefits (and patiently listening to me when I've spoken about those), and especially for demonstrating professionalism, excellence, and integrity in our varied workplaces. I'm heavily indebted to the members of the Chapter Executive Committee, who have generously contributed mighty efforts, amazing creativity, and precious time to benefit the chapter and all of us who belong to it. My heartfelt thanks and admiration go to J. W. Bryan, Jetta Collett, Linda Hinton, Laura Johnson, Christina Keyes, Phil Nally, Tommie Richie, Kathy Roney, Sandra Rudic, Amy Small, and Lee Ann Watters.

As for AGA's new beginnings, Jetta Collett will succeed me in June. She has recruited a wonderful mix of fresh and familiar faces, and I'm eagerly looking forward to seeing what her enthusiasm and ideas will bring to chapter leadership. I encourage all chapter members to work with her to continue improving the chapter's service to its members and to promoting genuine excellence and accountability in government.
